



SPRINKLER HEADS

MAINTENANCE TIPS

It is extremely rare for sprinkler heads to spontaneously burst. Human error is the cause of most unintentional sprinkler activation. Did you know that a single sprinkler head can release more than 20 gallons of water per minute, enough to fill a hot tub in ten minutes? In just a short time, this much water can cause major damage to your unit, as well as units beside or below you.

TIPS FOR MAINTAING SPRINKLER HEADS IN YOUR UNIT:

- Do not hang anything from your sprinkler line or heads. This includes electrical cords, cables, candle holders, clothing, and hangers.
- Keep an 18-inch clearance between the sprinkler head and items underneath to allow proper disbursement of water.
- Maintain adequate levels of personal insurance including water damage and sewer back-up.
